DRESS CODE Please discuss the DRESS CODE with your student. The students have been very cooperative in following the dress code and we appreciate it. As you plan your back to school shopping, please keep the following dress requirements in mind:

SHOES: K-4 NO rubber flip flops may be worn on campus. All sandals and crocs must be worn with a back strap. Tennis shoes must be worn on PE days.

5-8 NO rubber flip flops may be worn on campus. Sandals and crocs are allowed. Tennis shoes must be worn on PE days.

BOYS : Grade 3-8

- No sleeveless tees are to be worn to school.
- All pants and shorts should be worn appropriately at the waistline. No underwear should be showing.
- All hats, except Kippot are for use outside the classroom only.
- Pardes shirts are to be worn on Fridays.

GIRLS: Grades 3-8

- No halter tops, spaghetti straps, tube tops or sleeveless tees are to be worn to school. Cap sleeves are permissible. Sleeveless tees allowed in 3rd and 4th Grades only.
- The length of shorts and skirts may not be shorter than half-way between the waist and the knee.
- No bare midriffs.
- All hats, except Kippot are for use outside the classroom only.
- Pardes shirts are to be worn on Fridays.
