Through our weekly classes, your child will learn to express his or her thoughts, ideas, and feelings in new and creative ways.

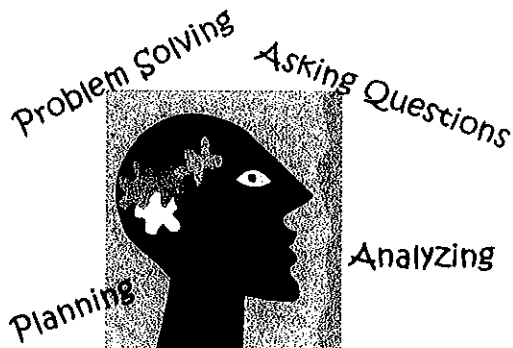

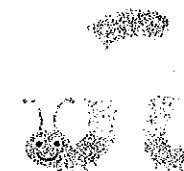

Extended care is offered Monday through Friday

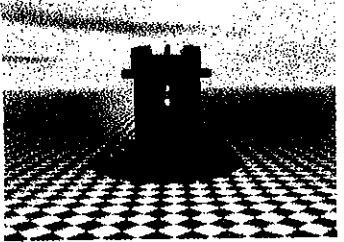
Before Care: 7:30 - 8:20 am

Open to students in Kindergarten through 3rd grade, this program will help develop your child's social coping skills while teaching sportsmanship and group decision making.

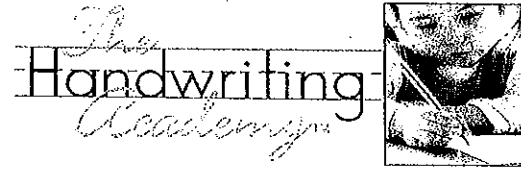
